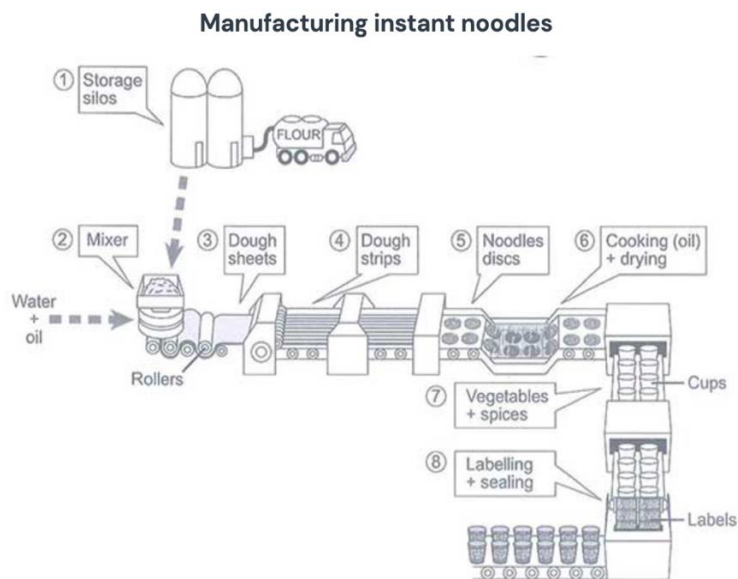


IELTS ACADEMIC WRITING TASK 1

Practice Question 1

The diagram below shows how instant noodles are manufactured.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.



The diagram illustrates the process by which instant noodles are produced.

It can be clearly seen that the overall process consists of eight steps, starting with the storage of flour in silos and concluding with the labelling and sealing of cups.

At first, the flour is stored in the silos. Then, it is transferred to a mixer where it is mixed with water and oil. After this step, the material is rolled out to form dough sheets, which are subsequently run through a machine to divide into strips.

These dough strips are then shaped into discs of noodles. The next stage involves cooking them in oil and letting them dry. These dried noodle discs along with vegetables and spices are then added to the cups. In the last step of the process, the cups are labelled and sealed.
